Dear Parents:

In order to prepare for your child's entrance into the Lower School, we ask that you choose from the enclosed foreign language options for new students entering The Summit Country Day School.

The foreign language program offers students the opportunity to study three languages before reaching the seventh grade. Students will begin studying their first language, French or Spanish, in kindergarten through the second grade. Beginning in third grade, students study the alternate language through the fifth grade. All sixth grade students are required to study Latin. Near the conclusion of the sixth grade year, each family will have their student choose to pursue either the formal study of French, Latin or Spanish. This can lead to an advanced placement college level course for college credit at the twelfth grade.

Lower School students will study general music by using the Orff Music instruments.
