

SUMMIT K-6 SAY SOCCER – Spring --Deadline: Friday, February 1, 2008—Fall—May 30th, 2008

REGISTRATION PROCESS -- Complete the registration form on the following page using a separate form for each player. *Send registration form and check for 79.00 for each player (payable to Summit Boosters) to SAY Soccer Volunteer, Summit Country Day School, 2161 Grandin Rd, Cin. 45208... Please Add 15 for short/socks or shirts or 27 for complete uniform*

SPRING SEASON 2008– The spring season is open to all K-6 graders at the Summit. It is a ten game outdoor season is tentatively scheduled for April 5 – .May 25th Games are played on Saturdays and Sundays versus other Eastside schools/organizations on fields assigned by SAY (Soccer Association for Youth). We will not know our field assignments and game schedules until the week before the season begins. Practice frequency is determined by your coach. Most Summit teams will practice once per week.

FALL SEASON 2008- Registration will be due May 30th, 2008, please check back for current forms and procedures after Spring season concludes. Unfortunately, SAY does not offer a fall season for kindergarteners yet, although five year olds are eligible to attend the Summit summer soccer camps.

TEAM FORMATION – Players are grouped by gender and age/grade and assigned randomly. Children in grades 5 and up are assigned to teams by random draw with a SAY representative. Late registrants are not guaranteed placement on teams.

UNIFORMS -- Game day uniform consists of a royal blue shirt, shorts and soccer socks. New players can purchase a full uniform via the registration form (“Full Uniform”). Returning players have three options: 1) for complete uniform select “Full”, 2) for a new shirt select “T-Shirt only”, 3) for no uniform, select “None required.” Handed down Summit uniforms are fine.

COST – Registration fee covers: SAY fees, referee costs, team equipment, individual trophies, team photos, and professional trainers. Be certain to select the appropriate uniform request box on the registration form: **\$79** --For player ordering NO uniform, **\$94** – For player ordering uniform SHIRT or shorts/socks only, **\$106** – For player needing FULL uniform (shirt, shorts and socks). Parents are responsible for purchasing shin guards, soccer/gym shoes and a soccer ball, all of which are required at each practice and game.

COACHES – Please consider volunteering as a coach where indicated on the registration form. *For any team not having a volunteer coach, we will attempt to hire a paid trainer for practices. In that case, parents of the team will be assessed an extra fee to pay for the training.* SAY offers a Coaches Clinic to help prepare volunteers to properly coach the players. Coaches and Assistant Coaches must complete a SAY Volunteer Application Form (download from www.saysoccer.org and return with your child’s registration)

SPECIAL PROJECTS- please consider volunteering for special projects. We have a variety of easy to manage projects which are a fun, low maintenance way to get involved. Most of these activities take only a few hours of your time each season. So if you enjoy the soccer, why not pitch in to help make it better. We need help with trophy ordering, picture ordering, uniform ordering, team mom’s to help communicate to team coaches and commissioner, and we’d like to organize a banquet committee. Just make a note on the form that you are willing to help and we’ll get hold of you.
